Geography Whole School Overview. Our teaching of Geography is taught on a fortnightly basis in KS1. In nursery and reception history is interweaved throughout continuous provision with a particular emphasis in the area of 'Understanding the World – People, culture and communities'. Our key concepts are revisited throughout the children's time at school. This is to ensure that progression will enable children to build on their schema and move their learning from working in to long term memory.

In our Early Years the principles of high quality provision underpin our curriculum. Our practitioners understand that all children are unique in the way and the rate at which they develop. Our practitioners will adjust their practice in response to individual children so that our curriculum meets their learning and developmental needs. All Areas of Learning and Development and the Characteristics of Effective Learning are interconnected. As the Prime areas of Learning and Development lay vital foundations in the development of 'Understanding the World' at Uplands Infant and Nursery school they are continuously in action and prioritised throughout the EYFS.
